There were many complaints about this course. Many students said the midterm was unfair and felt it did not test what they had learned but rather what they had memorized from the text. Test questions were difficult and students wanted more time to complete them. Also, the instructor could have been clearer about what was expected from them for the tests.

Assignments were marked harshly and with little or no feedback, and again the expectations were not clearly laid out. Students also felt that a course website would have been very useful for the posting of lecture notes and slides. Tutorials were another thing that students felt would have been helpful - especially for answering questions, reviewing lecture material and getting better explanations of assignments.

Mays, while passionate about architecture, did not communicate the material effectively. Some students found lectures unstructured and boring at times and wished lectures dealt with the readings as well. Others felt Mays could have been more enthusiastic in his presentation.
