Also, students complained about the lack of handouts and the poor choice in textbook. Students were also unhappy with the treatment of Spanish grammar, many claiming that due to the fast pace of lectures, and the mostly oral nature of the lectures, they had to teach themselves Spanish grammar. She was also unclear in her explanations.

Students also found the difficulty level to be much greater than SPA 100Y. The readings were far too advanced and rarely dealt with Spanish culture. Students also found that the tests did not reflect what had been learned in class.

Students were unhappy with the tutorial discussions as they found that fluent Spanish speakers tended to dominate whereas newer Spanish students tended to lag behind.
