RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. All full-time undergraduate students in the Faculty of Arts and Science, registered on the St. George campus, and fee-paying members of the Arts and Science Students' Union (ASSU) as defined by the ASSU Constitution are eligible to run for the position of ASSU Executive.
- 2. This nomination form must be filled out properly and completely as per the Election Procedures and submitted to an ASSU Staff Member before the nomination period closes.
- 3. No one person can be nominated for more than one position within the ASSU Executive, including the position of President.
- 4. Nominators must be full-time undergraduate students in the Faculty of Arts & Science, as per the ASSU Constitution. No nominator can nominate more than one person for any given position on the ASSU Executive. Each candidate for President must receive a minimum of 25 nominators.

- Nominations close Thursday, March 16th at 5 p.m. All nomination forms must be emailed to ASSU students.assu@utoronto.ca or handed in to the office (SS1068) and signed by an ASSU Staff member to be valid.
- The election will take place at the final meeting of ASSU Council on Friday, March 24th, at 4 pm LM 162. (Elections will not start until around 5 pm). Voting is restricted to members of ASSU Council as prescribed by the ASSU Constitution.
- 7. The nominee fully agrees to all rules and regulations governing the election. Any violation of the rules and regulations could disqualify a candidate. It is the responsibility of each candidate to make sure they are fully aware of all election rules, regulations, and procedures, as outlined in the Election Procedures, the ASSU Constitution, and the ASSU By-Laws.
- 8. Term of office is in-person and starts on May 1, 2023 and ends on April 30, 2024.
